Terms and Conditions:

1. The service provider of the facility shall be authorized by the Pollution Control Board of Karnataka and shall comply with the provisions of environment protection acts & rules there under and any other conditions which come into force from time to time.
2. The BMW carrying vehicles should have labels as in Part A of schedule IV along with necessary information as specified in Part-B of schedule-4. The vehicles used for transportation BMW shall comply with the conditions if any stipulated by Karnataka state pollution control board in addition to requirement contained in Motor vehicles act 1988 (59 of 1988). If any or the rules made them under for transportation of such infectious materials.
3. The tenderer of the facility shall maintain records of handling BMW and shall make monthly statement along with the bill to the concerned health care institute for periodic review.
4. The Collection and transportation of biomedical waste shall be carried out in a manner so as to avoid any possible hazard to human health and environment. The timing of collection of the waste will be preferable before noon. Should visit RH and MH and daily bases.
5. The Bio-Medical Waste collected in colour coded bags shall be transported to the Bio medical waste processing unit in a fully covered vehicle. Such vehicle shall be dedicated for transportation of Bio Medical Waste only and provided by the Agency.
6. The service provider shall maintain all the records related to Bio-Medical Waste Management of all the units. Daily records shall be maintained for the waste accepted and treated waste removed from the site. This record shall include the following minimum details. Waste Accepted: waste collection date, quantity of waste collected, category of waste, name of the health care unit, as per the rules, vehicle number.
7. The Agency shall ensure daily removal of all Bio-Medical Waste generated in the hospitals failing which the onus of violation will be solely on the agency, the same will be informed to the higher authorities and Legal action will be initiated for non compliance and no payment shall be made for the day of non-collection.
8. BBMP will not be held responsible for the damage, which can occur from time to time to the equipment or personnel during the entire process of collection, transport and disposal.
9. BBMP will not be responsible for any violation of rules and regulations committed by the agency.
10. The tenderer must arrange to collect, transport and dispose all BMW waste generated in the health care institutes.
11. The service provider should collect, transport and dispose the biomedical waste as per the Karnataka pollution control board guidelines issued time to time. (Enclose guidelines as enclosures).
12. Should submit monthly bills within 5th of every month.
13. All other terms and conditions remain same as per the tender.



Payment:

1. Should submit the monthly bills in triplicate along with the attendance, statement of BMW collected and disposed, within 5th of every month.

2. Should submit the bills of the MH, RH & Dialysis units to the Concerned Assistant Surgeons to generate the DC bill (P-code: P0051, Budget code 08-222003), later DC bills must be counter signed by Medical superintendents of Referral Hospitals, after the counter signature of Medical Superintendents the file should be submitted to zonal Accounts Office of (Finance) through Zonal Health officers (clinical).
3. Payment will made at the zonal Accounts Office of (Finance), after the verification of the DC bill.
4. In case of deficiencies in providing quality service, BBMP will have the right to impose penalty as per decision of the competent authority which shall be deducted from the monthly bill.
5. The defaulting firms shall be liable to pay the extra expenditure if any, incurred by the department for having got the work done elsewhere because of the failure of the firm to carry out the work in time.
6. Should ensure daily removal of all Bio-medical waste generated in the Hospital, failing which the onus of violation will be solely on the agency and the same will be informed to the KSPCB for legal action. In addition, the agency will be liable for the deduction of average daily pay in their monthly bill for default in performance of their duties and the criminal and civil liabilities arising out of the Bio-medical waste.
7. There will be deductions in payments for absent days of service in the bill.
8. All other terms and conditions remain same as per the tender.
